Separate sealed bids will be received for the Sheriffs Cove Dredging.

A conditional or qualified bid will not be accepted if it modifies the Plans or Specifications or methods of work. There will not be a pre-bid meeting; however, potential bidders are encouraged to visit and familiarize themselves with the site (Latitude 40°21'55.09" N, Longitude 123°25'38.85" W). A site overview can be arranged by contacting Pat Kaspari at GHD Inc. by telephone at (707) 443-8326.

The work consists of the furnishing of all labor, materials, equipment, and supervision for the removal of approximately 5,000 Cubic Yards of sediment and granular soils from the banks of the unnamed creek flowing into Sheriffs Cove, Ruth Reservoir, Ruth California. The Humboldt Bay Municipal Water District (HBMWD) will provide a long reach excavator for the work. Contractor to provide an operator with experience operating a long reach excavator, trucks and drivers to haul and deposit the material approximately 0.25 miles from the dredge site, and necessary sediment and erosion control measures as shown on the plans by GHD Inc. HBMWD will obtain all necessary permits.

Bids will be received by the District General Manager of HBMWD at the District Office, 828 Seventh Street, Eureka, CA until 3:00 p.m. Pacific Standard Time Tuesday, October 10, 2017 and then at said office publicly opened and read aloud.

Successful bidders will be required to furnish both a Payment Bond and Performance Bond in the full amount of the Contract Price. In accordance with Public Contract Code Section 10263, the Contractor will be allowed to substitute securities for monies normally withheld by the owner to insure performance under this contract.

The general prevailing wage rates applicable to the work are set by the Director of the Department of Industrial Relations under Labor Code Section 1771.4. The Contractor will be required to comply with any changes in these wage rates as they are updated by the State government at no cost to the Owner.
